The Women's Assistant Coach holds a key supporting role in preparing CUBC's Squad for the Boat Race, National Trials and summer regattas such as Henley Royal Regatta. The role includes specific responsibility for the coaching of Blondie, the Women's Reserve Crew.

Candidates must be able to work in the UK and the following competencies are desirable:

- Expert knowledge of the Tideway or competing in tidal conditions.
- Relevant success as a rower or cox competing at the highest level.
- Current driver's licence – ideally to include B+E towing endorsement.

The Club is seeking to make a prompt appointment to this important role in order that the successful applicant join CUBC as close as possible to the commencement of the 2022 Boat Race program in early September. An appropriate compensation package including accommodation will be agreed with the successful applicant. The remuneration package will be similar to the current level.
